CONSTITUTING A TECHNICAL WORKING COMMITTEE ON THE AMENDMENTS OF EXISTING DOST IP RELATED POLICIES

In view of the approval of the amendments to the Implementing Rules and Regulation of RA 10055 otherwise known as the "Philippine Technology Transfer Act of 2009" by DOST and IPOPHL and in the interest of service, a Technical Working Committee is hereby constituted to prepare, formulate and recommend amendments to the following DOST IP related Policies:

- 1. Review existing IP related policies as above enumerated and identify and recommend areas for improvement;
- 2. Draft proposed amendments to the said policies;

- 3. Conduct at least three (3) public hearings to elicit the views of the stakeholders as regards the proposed amendments;
- 4. Present the Draft amendments to the IP related policies to authorities of DOST.

Further, the Committee shall submit a work plan with timeline to the undersigned for approval. The Technical Working Group shall likewise perform such other functions as may be necessary to carry out this particular mandate.

The Technical Working Committee and its Secretariat shall be entitled to receive honoraria in accordance with items 3.2.3 of the DOST Circular No. 001 series of 2009 chargeable against the DOST-GIA subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Further in view of the urgency and volume of work necessary to complete the responsibilities of the Committee, said members are also exempted from the limit of two (2) meetings per month.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force and effect until the accomplishment of the purpose for which this working committee was created.
